Balance of account is credited in a lump sum as a pending payroll deduction, which will be split among your paychecks over the term. Check your account after each pay day to confirm that the deduction posted and no charges are immediately due.

Graduate Associate, 50% FTE (20 working hours per week)	100% of tuition/instructional fees (including tech fees, if applicable), 85% of health insurance premium. Payroll deduction for health insurance premium is a pre-tax deduction.	Fee Auth, GA
Graduate Associate, less than 50% FTE (10-19 working hours per week)	50% of tuition/instructional fees (including tech fees, if applicable) only. These appointments are not eligible for pre-tax benefits.	Fee Auth, GA
Graduate Fellow/Graduate Trainee	100% of tuition/instructional fees (including tech fee, if applicable), 85% of health insurance premium. Fellows are not employees and are not eligible for pre-tax benefits.	Fee Auth, FT
